Piotr Jaworski is a polish conductor, pianist and vocal coach based in Vienna, Austria. Guest Conductor of Orchestra Filarmonica Pugliese – OFP and Orchestra Sinfonica do Lecce e di Salento – OLES. He is working as a Vocal Coach in Opera Studio of Wiener Staatsoper. He has performed so far in many countries (England, Germany, Austria, Italy, Bulgaria, Spain, Belgium, Poland, Croatia, Czech Republic) leading such orchestras as Orchestra Filarmonica Pugliese – OFP, Junge Philharmonie Brandenburg, Cracow Philharmonic Orchestra, Beethoven Academy Orchestra - OAB, Orchestra Sinfonica do Lecce e di Salento – OLES, Camerata Musica Wien, Stadtorchester Pressbaum, Webern Kammerphilharmonie, *Pro Arte* Orchestra in Vienna, Kharkiv State Opera Orchestra, Karlsbad Symphony Orchestra.
